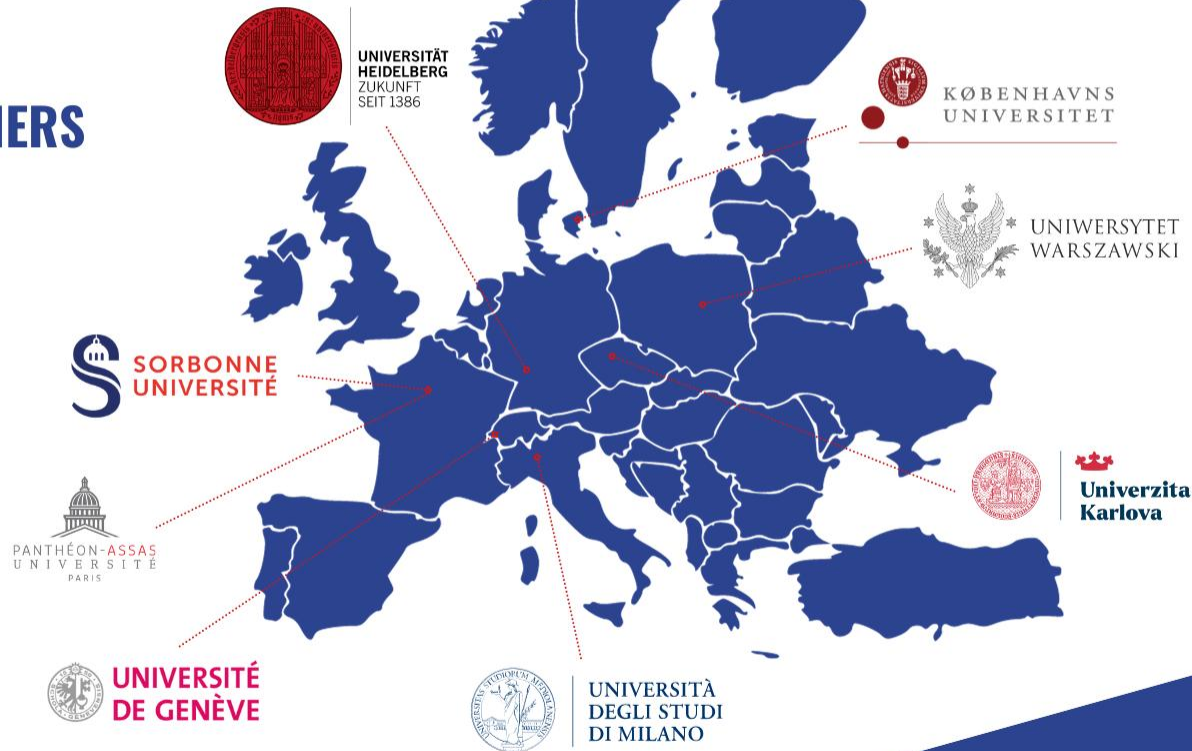

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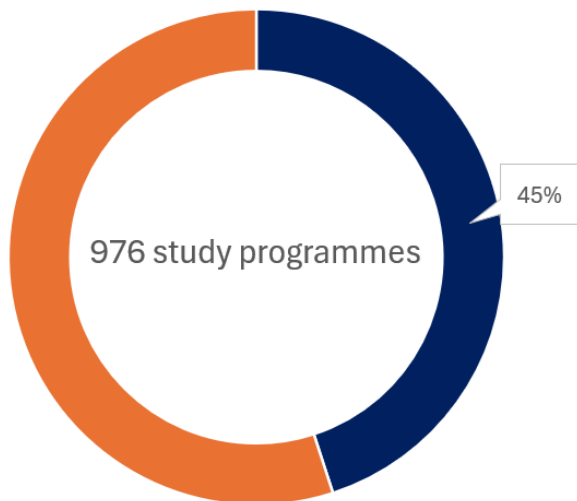

- Oldest German university (founded in 1386)
- Focus on research-based teaching and well-structured training for doctoral students



PhD at Heidelberg University

- 9.343 PhD candidates (30%)
- an individual basis or within a structured doctoral program (currently more than 40)
- three different forms of structured doctoral programs
 - **Graduate Schools (Graduiertenschulen)** – large facilities with 150–300 doctoral candidates covering a wide range of research fields
 - **Research Training Groups (Graduiertenkollegs)** – medium-sized groups with 15–50 doctoral candidates, variety of research fields within a defined topic area
 - **Research Training Groups (Promotionskollegs)** – small groups with five to seven doctoral candidates covering very specific research questions

Service Point: Services and stipends for doctoral candidates and postdocs

- Advising and support for doctoral candidates and postdocs on all general, non-subject related issues
- Advising and support for international doctoral candidates on visas and residence permits, insurance, housing and other questions about living in Heidelberg
- Doctoral fellowships; completion grants; publication grants; travel grants

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4EU+ Mobility Framework

■ Mobility Charter

- To make individual learning pathway possible
- To multiply mobility options
- Deals with topics related to mobility

■ Mobility Scheme

- List of all mobility options with funding possibilities in the Alliance
- Student x academic x administrative
- Physical x blended x virtual
- Short-term x long-term

Mobility Agreements

- Erasmus+ Agreement
 - open to students of all study areas within the 4EU+ in all study cycles
 - no limits on exchange numbers in general
 - extra agreement for medicine
- Agreement on Short-Term, Virtual and Blended Mobility
 - open to students of all study areas within the 4EU+ in all study cycles
 - covering all mobility types out of Erasmus+ framework

General conditions

- Funding is provided by home university
- Except for UNIGE, all partners are in the Erasmus+ programme
- For students
 - at all study cycles and all study areas
 - without tuition fees
 - the funding doesn't have to cover real costs
 - in E+, mobility funded up to 12 months in total per study cycle
- For staff
 - both academics and non-academics can participate

Erasmus+ & SEMP study stays

- For students at all study cycles
- Duration: 2–12 months
- Funding rates differ according to the home university's national E+ rates and the country of the host university
 - in SEMP, also incoming students are funded

Erasmus+ & SEMP traineeship

- For students at all study cycles
- Duration: 2–12 months
- Funding rates differ according to the home university's national E+ rates and the country of the host university
- At least 20 hours of training per week

Erasmus+ Short-term PhD mobility

- For PhD candidates of all study areas
- Duration: 5–30 days
- Funding:
 - Day 1–14: 79 EUR/day
 - Day 15–30: 56 EUR/day
- Not available for UNIGE

Erasmus+ & SEMP top ups

- Green Erasmus: 50 EUR for travelling sustainably
 - train, bus, boat or shared car
- Green SEMP: 100 CHF
 - train, bus and shared car (no ferry)
- Students with special needs
- 4EU+ top up given by SU

Erasmus+ & SEMP staff mobility

- Duration: 2 days–2 months
 - may be restricted by university (for example 2 days–2 weeks)
- Funding rates differ per home and host university
 - cover real costs, but upper limits given
 - travel allowances based on distance

Erasmus+ & SEMP staff mobility – teaching

- For academic staff
 - full-time, but also part-time staff
- At least 8 hours of teaching per week (or proportion for shorter mobility)
- Giving lectures, seminars, consultations, preparation of educational activities and joint/double degree programmes...

Erasmus+ & SEMP staff mobility – training

- For both academic and non-academic staff
 - full-time, but also part-time staff
- Language courses, staff training weeks, job shadowing...

4EU+ projects and activities

- The same scheme for funding mobility:
 - Educational projects
 - SEED4EU+ projects
 - FoCUs
 - Some other activities that don't fit into Erasmus+ programme
- For all students participating in activities
- Duration: up to 2 months

4EU+ projects and activities – rates

- Common funding frame
- Daily allowances
 - Day 1–14: **79 EUR/day**
 - Day 15–30: **56 EUR/day**
 - Up to two months: proportional monthly E+ rate/week
- Travel allowances based on distance and green travel

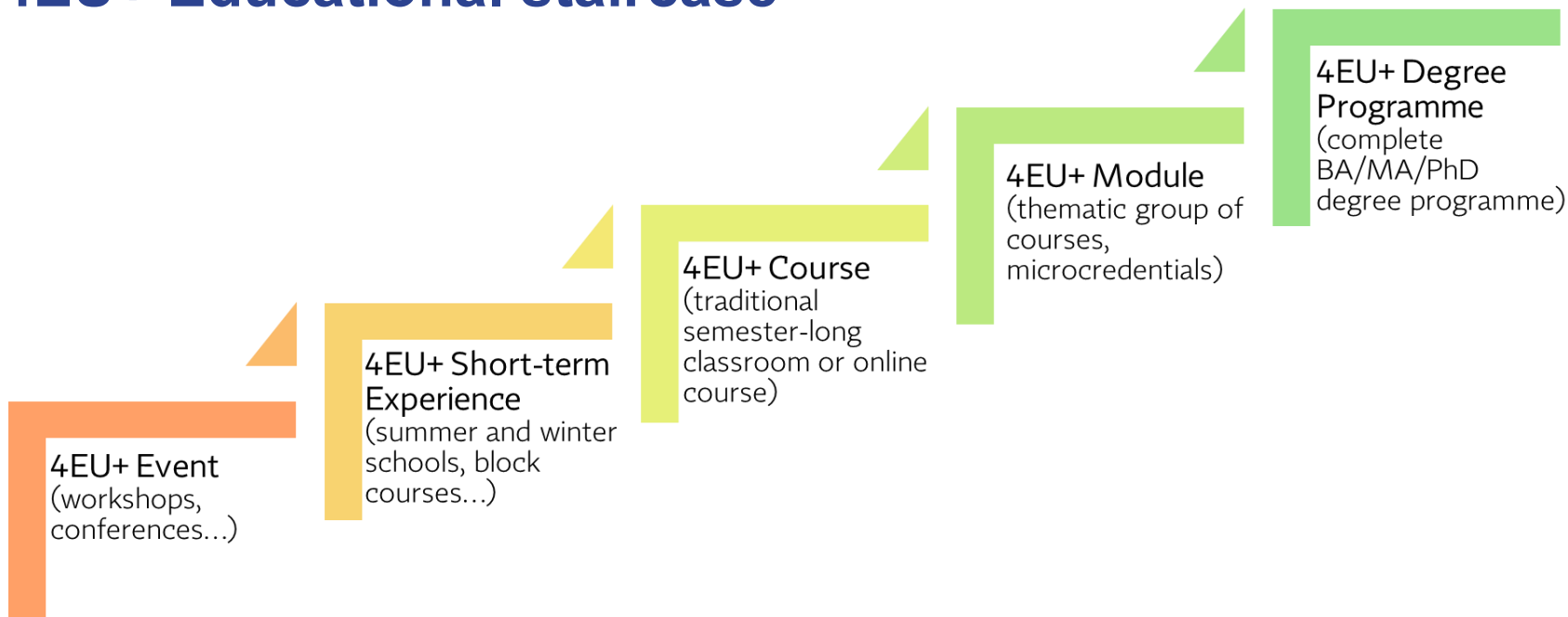
4EU+ staff mobility

- Real cost coverage, but might be upper limits
- Processes and administrative rules depends on each university/faculty
- EDU project, FoCUs 4EU+, flagship meetings, curricula comparison workshops, 4EU+ meetings, networking activities etc.

Virtual Mobility

- Offer available at [Student Portal](#)
- Registration and deadlines differ by host university
- 4EU+ Learning Agreement obligatory for enrollment
 - signed by student and home university
- Recognition and ECTS transfer – to be checked with home university!
 - Transcript of Records and 4EU+ LA needed

Events

- Updated offer of activities and events available at [4EU+ website](#)
- Workshops, lectures, conferences, flagships' activities, calls for involvement in 4EU+ etc.
- In-person as well as online

Shared Courses

- Courses offered **online** to students from partner universities for free
 - Mix of local, international and 4EU+ students
 - Open to every student at every 4EU+ university
- **Over 1500 courses** since AY 2020/21
- Over 2300 4EU+ students

Shared Courses and Virtual Mobility – courses

- Any lecturer can offer a course to be shared
- General conditions set by the Alliance
 - 4EU+ syllabus
 - key competences or other affiliation to 4EU+ educational framework
 - Taught in online or hybrid (in-person and online students together) mode
- No funding
- Included in teaching workload

SEED4EU+

- Internal funding for 4EU+ „out-of-the-box“ initiatives
- Cooperation of at least three universities with one of them leading the activity
- The leader must have the PhD degree completed, but candidates may be members of the team
- Affiliation to the 4EU+ (Flagships) and its goals
- Focus on research in any scientific area, education, innovation, and/or public engagement/citizen science activities
- 50.000 EUR for 12 months
- Current call closed 3th October

FoCUs 4EU+

- New format starting in 2026
- Offered by CU = **the leader must be from CU**
- Synergy projects:
 - Academic (since 2020, 146 in total) and student (since 2022, 37 in total) edition
 - 4EU+ project rules, just smaller in scale
 - Ideal for the first experience in managing a project
 - Calls twice a year
- Bridging projects
 - For individual mobility within 4EU+ or to represent 4EU+

Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes

- Consists of physical and virtual mobility
 - duration of physical mobility is 5–30 days
 - duration of virtual part is not specified
- At least 3 partner universities, one of them as coordinator
- 10–20 participants from partner institutions
- At least 3 ECTS per program
- For students or staff

Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes – funding

- To coordinator (organizer): for the delivery of the program
 - 400 EUR per participant = up to 8.000 EUR
- To participants:
 - Day 1–14: 79 EUR/day
 - Day 15–30: 56 EUR/day

4EU+ Pilot Call on Blended Intensive Programmes

- Testing BIPs on the Alliance level of administration
 - Ad hoc projects already running
- Mix of E+ and 4EU+ conditions
- In total 8 submitted proposals
 - Organized by UHD, UNIMI, and UW
- Activities carried in AY 2025/2026
- Next call planned in 2026

4EU+ Joint doctoral programmes

- Co-supervised doctoral research projects based on regular cotutelle programme
- 3-year contract, including a year at partner university
- Paid spots offered:
 - 4 by SU
 - 2 by CU
 - 1 by UNIMI
 - *UNIGE joins with standard cotutelle system

4EU+ Visiting Professorships

- Funding for 1-2-month stay at partner university
 - Covering mobility expenses (travel and living costs)
- For research and/or teaching to deepen cooperation between host and home universities
- Focus on early-career researchers (up to 7-year post-PhD experience)
- Next call planned for 2026

4EU+ Grant Support Service (GSS)

- To help the academic staff of the 4EU+ with funding opportunities within the 4EU+ network
- **For internal 4EU+ calls**
- Help with finding partners for cooperation within the Alliance
- In touch with all Local Offices of the 4EU+ members
- Planned workshops and lectures
- 4euplus.eu/4EU-738



Student and PhD representation

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4EU+ Academic Council

- Advisory and consultative body to the 4EU+ Governing Board
- Each university has 6 representatives
 - 3 academics
 - 2 students (one of them PhD)
 - 1 admin staff
- Main part of Internal Auditing Board
- Strategic planning, coordination of activities, ad hoc topics

4EU+ Student Committee

- Representation of BA, MA students, and PhD candidates
- Each university has 3 representatives
 - At least one of them PhD
- Coordinating students bodies in the Alliance

4EU+ Student Ambassadors

- Promotion of 4EU+ and its activities
- Representatives of all partner universities
- New call for representatives running
