Funding of joined workshops and short-term programmes for graduate students and academic staff from 4EU+ universities

Heidelberg University is a member of the 4EU+ alliance, consisting of **Charles University in Prague**, **Heidelberg University**, **Sorbonne University** in Paris, the **University of Warsaw**, the **University of Copenhagen** and the **University of Milan**. 4EU+ aims to create a new quality of cooperation between the six universities in manifold areas. The goal is the creation of a 'European University' with compatible courses of study, flexible study paths for students and manifold mobility options for students and academic staff (www.uni-heidelberg.de/en/4eu-european-university-alliance).

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) provides financial support for joined workshops and short-term programmes in the framework of its **supporting programme 'European University Networks'.** Funding is available e.g. for workshops, block seminars, summer schools etc. at **Heidelberg University** for graduate students (Master and Doctoral) from 4EU+ universities.

Primarily activities that are not eligible for funding from the "Flagship Projects" (<u>https://4euplus.eu/4EU-35.html</u>) of the EU proposal "European Universities" are invited to apply.

Financial support of up to € 12.000 per activity can be provided for subsistence allowances for 5 days for up to 20 graduate students and 5 academic staff from 4EU+ partner universities as well as for conference material.

Beside Heidelberg University a minimum of two further 4EU+ universities should participate in the activity.
