

PATHWAYS

Multilingualism





- multilingual individuals
- multilingualism in space and society
- languages in contrast
- multilingual and multicultural communication

European Citizenship



- EU governance
- individuals, core values and fundamental freedoms
- history and historic-political relations
- literature and arts



Pathway can consist of:

- 1 dedicated 4EU+ courses with appropriate label
- courses from the student's study programme if they offer the appropriate learning outcomes
- the student should **collect up to 20 ECTS points** from a module **to be awarded a certificate**(at least 8 points need to be obtained from the course taught at a different 4EU+ university; up to 4 points can be obtained from a different module and up to 4 points from another pathway)



FOR ACADEMICS

How can the course I teach be included in the pathway?

- check the learning outcomes expected from the pathway
- if they overlap with the ones students obtain during your course, contact the coordinator
- your course will get the label "Multilingualism" or "European citizenship" and will be offered as a dedicated 4EU+ course





FOR STUDENTS

How can I get a recognition of a pathway?

- select course from the 4EU+ offer (announced each semester)
- if you attended the course with the learning outcomes matching those expected from the pathway contact the coordinator
- if you fulfill the requirements, you will get the recognition from the European University!







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
