## Fundamentals of e-learning Short module programme: Online Summer School "Sociology of Elites: Case Studies and Methods" prepared by the University of Warsaw

During the Workshop on the development of innovative didactic materials, tool and techniques in Warsaw, the representatives of UW Digital Competence Centre provided workshop "Fundamentals of e-learning". The training session was focused on basic issues concerning online teaching methodology, including:

- stationary vs. virtual class similarities and differences,
- e-teacher's and students' expectations,
- typology of e-courses,
- types of online students,
- e-teacher's roles,
- online classroom management: e-course organization, e-teacher-students communication, assessing students' work and providing feedback, dealing with disruptive behaviour, etc.,
- formulating and realizing the aims of an e-course.

Online Summer School "Sociology of Elites: Case Studies and Methods"
This short module programme created within API project by the University of Warsaw took place from 30<sup>th</sup> September to 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021 (2 days per week) and was organized by the Institute for Social Studies. Classes were prepared by the team of 10 lecturers and teaching assistants.

The course was divided into two parts:

## FIRST PART:

- Introduction to Pierre Bourdieu's field analysis: concepts and research methods,
- Historical analysis of the field of power in Poland,
- The Intelligentsia as a specific Central European type of elite,
- Polish universities during the communist period: an attempt to create a new elite,
- The 1989 transformation and development of the field of think tanks in Poland,
- Historical policy as a part of elites' struggles and their legitimization efforts.

## SECOND PART:

 Workshops dedicated to Multidimensional Correspondence Analysis, prosopographical analysis and network analysis.

The summer school was conducted fully online (synchronous meetings on Zoom platform).
