2024 Call

Deadline: 23 October 2024 at noon

- Multi- and interdisciplinary proposals are encouraged.
- 4-year funding starting in autumn 2025

- > Open spaces where people and ideas can grow
- Interdisciplinary research networks
- Researchers, innovators and other professionals, including industry specialists, who are based in Europe and beyond, to collaborate on research topics for a period of 4 years.
- Expenses of networking activities rather than research (organise and fund events, short-term scientific missions, training schools, communication activities, and virtual networking tools.) https://www.cost.eu/cost-actions-event/action-networking-tools/
- ➤ An estimated €125,000 is made available for a COST Action in its first year and an average of €150,000 per year for the other 3 years.

### How to apply

#### MUST criteria:

- contributing to the scientific, technological, economic, cultural or societal knowledge advancement and development of Europe.
- researchers from at least 7 COST Member countries, <u>half of</u> whom come from our Inclusiveness Target Countries (ITC)

### Eligible countries

- EU members
- Third countries <u>are associated</u> to the programme: Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, North Macedonia, Republic of Türkiye and Republic of Serbia

- Third countries <u>not</u> associated to the Programme: 1, 2<sub>2</sub> , 3, 5<sub>a</sub>, 6, 7<sub>a</sub>, 8<sub>a</sub>, 9, 10 and 11.

#### Participants (criteria)

- higher education institutions (HEIs) or organisations of HEIs;
- organisations or institutions active in the labour market or in the fields of education, training and youth.

#### Multi-country projects:

- at least 2 EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme; each of these countries must involve at least 1 HEI;
- at least 2 eligible third countries not associated to the Programme; each of these countries must involve at least 2 HEIs.

!!!! The <u>number of participating organisations</u> from third countries not associated to the Programme must be equal to or higher than the number of participating organisations from EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme

Open to all eligible regions: 1, 22, 3, 5a, 6, 7a, 8a, 9, 10 and 11.

#### National projects (open only for Regions 24, 3, 5a, 6, 7a, 8a, 9):

- at least 2 EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme; each of these countries must involve at least 1 HEI;
- only 1 eligible third country not associated to the Programme; involving at least 2 HEIs.

!!! The <u>number of participating organisations</u> from third countries not associated to the Programme must be equal to or higher than the number of participating organisations from EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme.
