


4EU+ European University Alliance: a short history



- Originally 4EU, the Alliance was founded in March 2018 by Charles University (Prague, Czech Republic), Heidelberg University (Heidelberg, Germany), Sorbonne University (Paris, France), and the University of Warsaw (Warsaw, Poland).
- In October 2018 it became 4EU+ with the addition of the University of Copenhagen (Copenhagen, Denmark) and the University of Milan (Milan, Italy).
- In August 2022, the University of Geneva (Geneva, Switzerland) joined 4EU+.

4EU+ Alliance: one vision, three challenges, six objectives


To build this new kind of integrated European university system, the 4EU+ Alliance will focus on three challenges:

- 1. Boost Meaningful Mobility
- 2. Increase inclusiveness and balance at a European level
- 3. Develop a common challenge-based framework for education



SEED4EU+ as a dedicated 4EU+ call



- Reflecting 4EU+ own and unique vision, going beyond the frame and limits defined by the ongoing Erasmus+ and Horizon 2020 projects co-funded by the European Commission,
- Call funded by the 4EU+ Alliance through member universities' own funding. Result of commitment of 7 member universities



SEED4EU+ as an open and inclusive call

- Deepening 4EU+'s commitment to create One Comprehensive Research-Intensive European University
- Unique design of the call for proposals covering research and innovation, education and outreach to society, thus fully responding to the missions entrusted to universities,
- Call widely open to all communities from 4EU+ universities, thus broadening their involvement in 4EU+.



SEED4EU+, a challenging call

- Seed money to develop the potential for excellence in 4EU+
- Looking for new transversal, transdisciplinary initiatives
- Strengthen existing cooperation within 4EU+ in all areas of education, research and innovation, and develop the third mission of 4EU+
- **Expand** 4EU+ communities
- Ensuring the **sustainability o**f cooperation within 4EU+
- Involve early career researchers and students in the proposals, building the (4EU+) academic community and the European society of tomorrow

What do you need to know?

Both existing and new interuniversity teams can submit project proposals



- Project teams have to include participants from at least 3 universities
- Who can apply? Researchers and academics starting from postgraduate level1 and affiliated to any
 of the seven 4EU+ universities
- The maximum funding available per project is 50,000 EUR
- Projects can run for a period of up to 12 months. An extension up to 24 months is possible on justified request, at least 3 months before the project closes
- APPLICATION DEADLINE: All proposals must be submitted electronically via the online application form by 1 June 2023, 16:00 CET

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VISITING PROFESSORSHIPS



4**CU**+ Many activities: for teaching & learning

- Participation in courses in the host universities by delivering lectures, seminars, laboratory training, field work ...
- Construction of joint learning modules or programs
- Transformation of teaching methods
- Preparation and delivery of summer or winter schools




- Building a 4EU+ research team
- Design or use of shared research infrastructure
- Producing preliminary results in view of a joint proposal for research grants
- Organization of high-level conferences

Outreach and communication activities to disseminate 4EU+ achievements within the non-academic sector and the society are also eligible.



- Fit into the host and home universities environment
- Disseminate efficiently

What do you need to know?

- The Visiting Professorship holder and the members of the hosting team must be affiliated with two different universities of the 4EU+ Alliance.
- The holder is expected to stay at the host university for a period of minimum 2 months and maximum 3 months; it be possible to split up the 2-3 months stay at visiting University.
- The holder continues to receive a salary determined and paid by the home university
- **APPLICATION DEADLINE:** All proposals must be submitted electronically via the online application form **by 1 June 2023, 16:00 CET!**





4EU+ calls : what do you need to know?

- > You can submit proposal both for Seed4EU and Visiting Professorship programme
- Please note that for a number of points, reference should be made to the regulations in force at the university concerned. Examples:

Visiting Professorship

- Specific eligibility requirements for candidates
- Amount of daily/monthly allowances
