# Introducing 4EU+ Alliance























#### 4EU+ European University Alliance: short history and numbers

- Originally 4EU, the Alliance was founded in March 2018 by Charles University (Prague, Czech Republic), Heidelberg University (Heidelberg, Germany), Sorbonne University (Paris, France), and the University of Warsaw (Warsaw, Poland).
- In October 2018 it became 4EU+ with the addition of the University of Copenhagen (Copenhagen, Denmark) and the University of Milan (Milan, Italy).
- In August 2022, the University of Geneva (Geneva, Switzerland) joined 4EU+.
- In July 2023, Paris-Panthéon Assas University (Paris, France) joined 4EU+.



#### **4EU+ VALUES**






#### 4EU+ Alliance: one vision, three challenges, six objectives


# Visiting Professorships 2024



#### **Principles**

- An academic from one partner university ("home university") has a chance to visit another university ("host university") for the period from 2 to 3 months.
- <u>The call</u> is open to researchers and academics of all scientific fields and disciplines corresponding to the thematic scope, missions and objectives of the <u>4EU+ Flagships</u>.







#### **Goals and vision**

- Indicate or consolidate European teams for research or education with very close ties that bring together the competencies and best practices from our universities;
- Enhance the knowledge and skills of our academic staff;
- Enlarge the community of people that are actively involved in 4EU+ activities.

- The Visiting Professorship holder is an academic staff member employed at a 4EU+ member university (i.e., employed by a 4EU+ member university with a commitment to research and/or teaching)
- + specific local eligibility requirements for employees of SU, UniGe, UniMi & UW.

- Required attachments:
  - full CV
  - brief personal introduction
  - confirmation letter from the home institution, signed by the head of the department/dean of the unit of the department, or the rector of the home university (in English)
  - letter of acceptance from the host university, signed by the head of the host department/dean of the unit of the host department or the rector of the hosting university (in English)



#### **Selection procedure**

- Eligibility check (letters of approval to ensure the formal eligibility)
- Evaluation Committee (representatives of 4EU+ Management Committee, Flagships, Academic Council, Student Committee)
- Budget allocation: Management Committee
- Final approval: Governing Board



#### **Evaluation Criteria**

- 45 % Thematic relevance and quality of the proposal
- 25 % Added value of the partnership
- 30 % Impact and sustainability
- + the project significantly increases the number of participants in 4EU+ activities, reaching a wider 4EU+ community.

## Funding

- Funding provided by the 4EU+ Association.
- A lump sum will be paid to the Visiting Professorship holder by the home university in accordance with the local legislative regulation, considering:
  - the fixed allowances at the home university, covering accommodation and subsistence, and
  - the travel allowance is **paid once** (the mobility period can be divided into several intervals over one academic year but only one travel can be funded).
- Application for co-funding of the Visiting Professorship or additional funding for subsequent related activities is allowed.



## Funding

 The daily and travel allowances are fixed for all universities based on the Erasmus+ Teaching Staff Mobility rates for long-term staff mobilities:

#### **VP holder duties**

- Plan a physical mobility of 2-3 months (virtual mobility and distant collaborative work can complement but not replace the physical mobility period);
- Work extensively with the **members of the host team**;
- Follow the approved budget;
- Continuously inform respective Local Office about the progress and activities to be carried out;
- Submit the final report (no later than 3m after the end of the VP period)





- How can I apply if I don't have any 4EU+ cooperation yet?
- It is possible to visit other Universities than those listed above?
- Regarding the activity to be done at the hosting university, i.e. research, organization, teaching, would it be agreed in advance?
- Is this action open to any subject area or are there specific priorities for it?
- To what extent must the proposed research project fit into the scope of the flagships?
- Is it applicable for researcher?
- The program lasts a maximum of three months, that is, less than a semester. For someone interested in the teaching part of this program, what are the tips for organizing classes within the semester in terms of time?
